



School Parliament meeting Friday 7th February 2025

We started our meeting with introductions, who we are and the class we represent.

We spoke about our role, to have a voice in the decisions of our school. We also discussed how to take turns and listen during the meeting when somebody is speaking, to show respect.

Our discussion for this meeting was based around behaviour and school rules. We talked about:

- What behaviour is like in school
- What happens if we make a mistake in relation to our behaviour
