



School Parliament meeting 9 October 2024

We started our meeting with introductions, who we are and the class we represent.

We spoke about our role, to have a voice in the decisions of our school. We also discussed how to take turns and listen during the meeting when somebody is speaking, to show respect.

Children shared notes that they had collected in their Parliament notebooks.

We discussed what is going well in school—the children identified:

- Good friends
- Reading outside with OPAL
- Our playground with OPAL

Mrs Lewis read out a letter from Mrs Chamberlain requesting that school parliament consider expectations for playing safely at lunchtimes—this will form our School Playtime Charter, which will help keep children safe and happy.

The children decided on the following 'rules' and expectations for safe play:

We take care of Equipment. We listen to each other. We share equipment fairly and kindly. We play safely. We let people join in our games.

These will be fed back to Mrs Chamberlain who will, alongside our Play team, choose 4 for our Playground Charter. Representatives of the School Parliament will help to present these in assembly.

The meeting was closed at 2.45pm after juice and biscuits.
