



School Parliament meeting 14 November 2025

We started our meeting with a welcome from Mrs Lewis and introductions by all of the children. We reminded ourselves about how we could be good listeners, respecting others when they speak, waiting our turn, being patient, looking at the person speaking.

The children shared some observations about what they had seen at school and some ideas for OPAL play at lunchtime. They would like to see:

- Climbing equipment, swings and more dressing up. ACTION—Mrs Lewis to pass this to Mrs Taylor and Mrs Clarke— OPAL lead teachers.

The children shared their learning from the week—we discussed what is bullying, and how to stop bullying and unkindness at Westdale.

The children knew that bullying is repeated unkind behaviour that is:

Several Times On Purpose

We talked about how sometimes accidents happen and someone may be bumped—but we have to repair and apologise.

The children knew what to do if someone was being unkind, 'stop I don't like that' and how to be an *upstander* to stop unkindness and bullying at Westdale.

The children stated that they all felt safe and could tell me who they could talk to if they were worried, upset or had a concern.

Everyone knew the Westdale Promise and could talk about what it meant.

Mrs Lewis asked for volunteers to help update our Westdale Anti Bullying leaflet. Lots of children were keen to help.

ACTION—team to update leaflet with advice, pictures to help children be safe and happy at Westdale.

Next time—walk around our school to check our Westdale Promise—taking care and respecting our school and each other.
