This week coming, we will be:

- Continuing to listen for different sounds in the environment , and playing musical instrument games in phonics.
- Continue learning all about number one and spotting it in our classroom!
- Singing 'The Wheels on the Bus' and going on bus journeys around our school.
- Spotting buses looking at the road from our playground.
- Listening to feelings stories to help our children express their emotions.
- Rolling cars through paint to make tracks on the paint.
- Drawing pictures using lines straight down, and across.
- Practice holding our pen using tripod grip.
- Spotting our own names using the pictures to help.

If you could all ensure that any cardigans/ jumpers and items they bring in including bags are labelled, that would be a massive help to us too. We try to keep their bags at nursery with their change of clothers in and then will send it back to you once it is empty or has wet clothers in.

This week we will also be sending home library books. These are books the child has chosen to take home. You then keep them for the week or so and bring them back to us. This is to encourage your child to hold the book, turn the pages, talk about it, and have a go at telling the story. We will then change library books with your child on a Tuesday and Thursday when they bring the previous one back to us.
