Hello everyone,

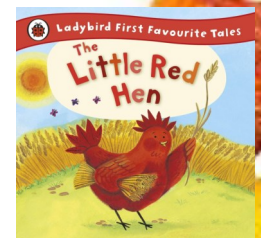
