

Little Stars Newsletter w/c 25th November

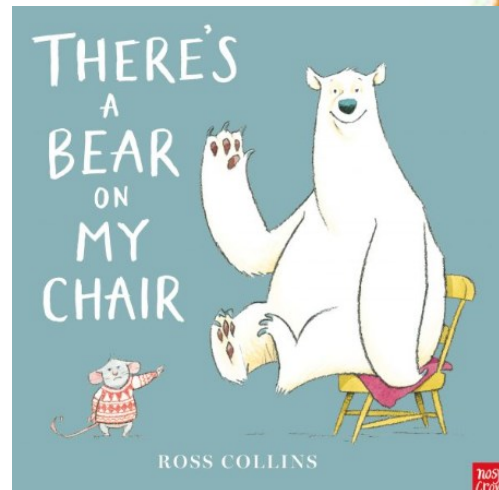


Hello everyone,

This week we have been finding everything in our classroom beginning with the sound 's'. The children have loved finding these objects in the sand and water trays! Have an 's' hunt at home to see what you can find! Next week we will be continuing the story 'There's a Bear on my Chair.' Everyone has loved this story and are amazing at spotting them tricky rhyming words!

We will be:

- Finding the sound 'A' in the sound box with Listening Len.
- Copying the first letter in my name.
- Learning how to write the zig zag mark 'up, down, up, down'.
- Learning how to count bears in a line, and knowing that the last number tells you how many there are.
- Creating and sticking bear faces.
- Talking about how we are feeling and what makes us feel that way.
- Learning how to brush our teeth with a toothbrush and know that we need to do this twice a day.
- Mixing the prime colours red, yellow and blue together to paint simple shapes.
- Using scissors and hammers to make our fingers strong ready for writing.
- Spotting rhyming words in our mud kitchen.
