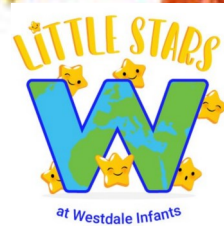


## Little Stars Newsletter w/c 14th October



Hello everyone,

This week we have been learning all about the sounds we can make with our bodies. If you want to help with this at home, you can play a game where your child copies your sound such as clap, clap, stomp (whilst saying the sound). We have been learning the sounds pop, click, clap, stomp, tap, ssh, and rub.

Next week we will be learning all about harvest time ready for our Harvest Festival. We will be reading the story of 'The Little Red Hen'. This is a fabulous story about a Hen that needs help from his friends to make bread!

We will be:

- Watching a video on how we make bread.
- Exploring flour and wheat in the tuff spot.
- Practicing our cutting skills to make puppets.
- Continuing to explore the Autumn leaves and resources.
- Singing our lovely songs about harvest time and thinking about all those farmers hard at work.
- Learning about rhythm in phonics and using our 'Listening Len' ears to see when it goes faster or slower.
- Using positional language such as under, on top, and in to hide the characters of our story.
- Practicing to use the pedals on the bikes in the big playground.
- Continue to act out feelings such as happy to help our children identify how they might be feeling.
