Wave 1 Every child has individual needs.



At Westdale Infants, each child will have an equal opportunity to work to their full potential so that they will learn to appreciate and value their own strengths. We believe all children should develop the skills and attitudes to enjoy learning.

We use trackers to monitor children's progress, breaking targets into manageable, individual steps. The class teacher and the SENCO monitor this regularly

Wave 2 We make appropriate provision to overcome all barriers to learning and ensure pupils with SEND have full access to the National Curriculum. All class teachers are responsible for day to day provision. They will devise appropriate strategies to overcome barriers to learning.



The class teacher and SENCO will work with families to ensure the best for the child.

Wave 3



We strive to work with parents and carers to gain a better understanding of their child, and involve them in all stages of their child's education. We will work with the support of outside agencies when the pupils' needs cannot be met by the school alone.



The SENCO at this point will be involved in all areas of children's provision. Records are kept at all times.
