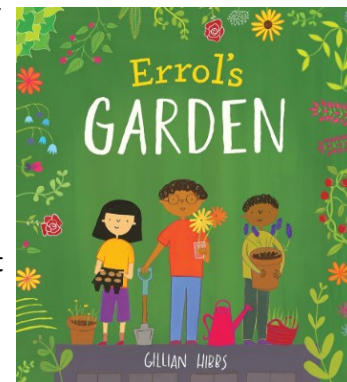
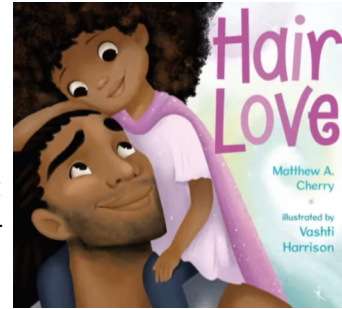
Hello Parents and Carers,

We have had a lovely week sharing the story 'Hair Love'. The children have enjoyed talking about how we are all different and we are all special. They especially enjoyed cutting noodles to make different hair styles and making hair with our sticky playdough!

Next week, we will be reading the story 'Errol's garden'

We will be:

- Talking about what makes a good friend. Role playing what we would do if we wanted a turn with a toy or if one of our friends needed some help.
- N2's will be learning the sounds 'b' and 'f'. They will be making silly soup with objects starting with these sounds. N1's will be exploring rhymes and listening for rhyming words.
- N2's will be making number bonds to 5 and comparing groups of objects using the language more and fewer. N1's will be counting out an amount from a larger group.
- Recognising and writing the number 3.
- Learning the names of some parts of plants such as leaf, stem and petal. Creating our own collage of a flower.
- Listening to some different pieces of music and talking about our likes and dislikes.
