

Little Stars Newsletter w/c 18-05-2026

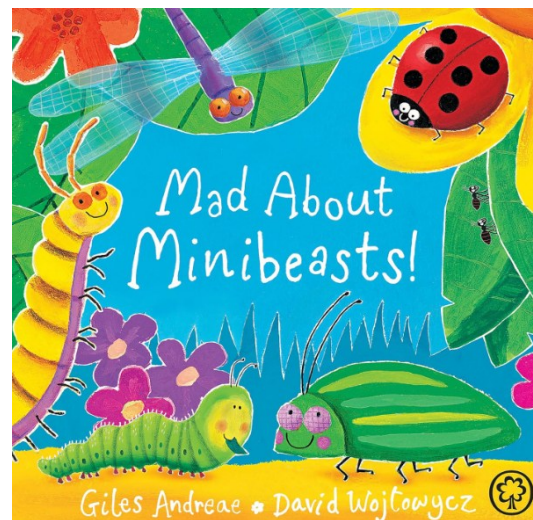
Hello parents and carers,

We have had a lovely week sharing the book 'Mad about Minibeasts'. They have loved learning the names of different minibeasts and learning facts about them. We especially enjoyed observing worms closely and talking about how their bodies and how they move. On Wednesday, we had a visit from the Fire Service to show us the Fire engine and talk to us about how they help us.

Next week, we will continue sharing the book 'Mad about Minibeasts'.

We will be:

- Searching for minibeasts in the garden with magnifying glasses and going on minibeast hunts in the big playground..
- Making bees with pattern striped paper.
- Looking at our baby photos and talking about how we change and grow.
- N2's will be learning the sounds v and w. They will be playing Musical Corners where they move to the correct corner for the sound they hear. N1's will be continuing to practise rhyming through song.
- In Maths, we will be making routes for the minibeasts and using positional language such as above, below, beneath and around.
- Singing music in high and low pitch voices whilst tapping along with our musical instruments.
- Practising using the pedals on a tricycle.
