Hello parents and carers,

This week we have loved exploring more minibeasts, especially the bee! They have learnt how they make honey and lots of interesting facts.

After half term we will be looking at the story 'Rubys Worry'. This is a lovely story explaining how we deal with a worry.

We will be:

- Singing the familiar nursery rhyme 'Head, Shoulders, Knees , and Toes'.
- Recapping the sounds we know in phonic so far.
- N2s (the children starting school in September) Blending and segmenting words on the phonics TV.
- N1s will be starting to learn the first sound in their name.
- Spotting the beginning, middle, and end in stories.
- Recapping the marks and pictures that we have drawn so far.
- Subitising numbers 1-5.
- Recapping all we know about numbers 1, 2 and 3.
- Counting to 20 in a string.
- Choosing it, using it, putting it away (superstar).
- Practising some sports day activities such as obstacles, beanbag throwing and hockey.

Sports day is on **Wednesday 10th June starting at 1:30pm**. Gates at the MUGGA across the road on Digby Avenue will open at 1:15pm. We will walk the children over and meet you over there. The children who will be starting school in September will be joining in (N2s).
