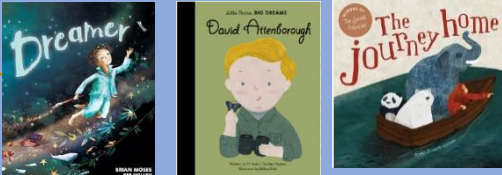
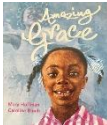


 Year 2 What a Wonderful World	Topic Trail Spring Term 1
