Hello parents and carers,

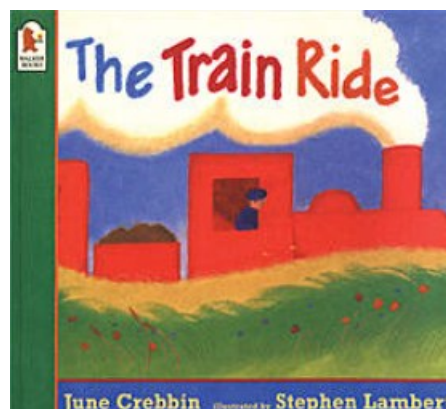


This week we been sharing the story 'The Train Ride' This has been an exciting story which has captivated the children. They have loved making tracks with the trains using the small world and paints. We have been looking at different types of trains and the amazing journeys that they go on.

Next week, we will be continuing this story and looking at journeys in more detail.

We will be:

- Singing the song 'Down at the Station'
- Recapping the sounds we know in phonic so far and learning the new sounds y and z.
- N2s (the children starting school in September) Blending and segmenting words on the phonics TV. We will be using toys to practise this.
- N1s will be singing 'Listening Len had a box' using rhyme.
- Making obstacle courses outside and practising our throwing and catching.
- Drawing a story map of the train journey.
- Looking at pictures of the Reception class and going for walks around it.
- Playing inside Receptions playground and meeting the new teachers.
- N2s will be counting out subgroups using vehicles.
- N1s will be making small world routes.
- Talking about change and how that makes us feel.
- Noticing signs of Summer outside.
