This week we have loved sharing the story 'Shark in the Dark'. We have enjoyed making sharks with fins, learning about sea creatures and especially exploring water and ice.

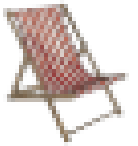
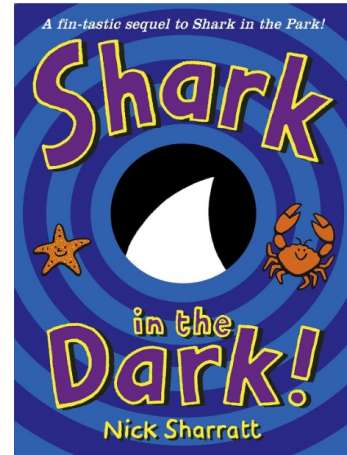


Next week, we will continue sharing the story 'Shark in the Dark'.

Please remember names sun hats in this hot weather every day.

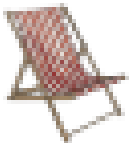
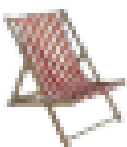


Dates to remember:
