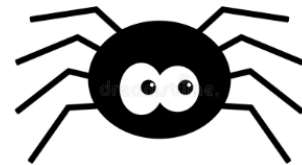


What a busy and exciting week we are having at Little Stars!

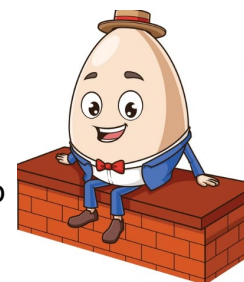
We have been doing lots of singing and reading nursery rhymes with a focus on 'Hairy Fred' and 'Incy Wincey Spider'. We have been:
