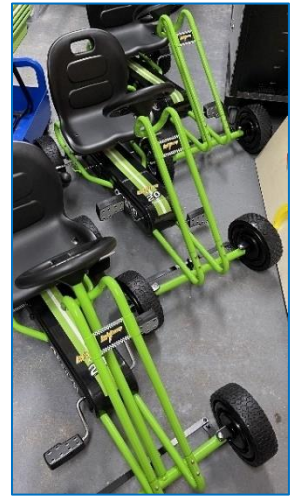
POW Valentine's Disco
