After half term we will be singing the nursery rhyme 'Hot Cross Buns.' This half term's book is all about people in the community such as bakers, and pets!

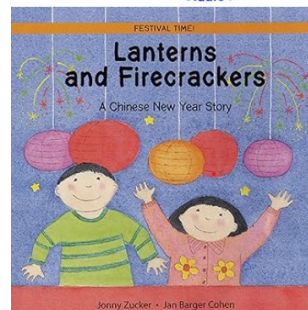
We will be:
